Primary School - Grade 1-7

1. All learners regardless of their gender, from grade 1 – 7 may participate in this category.
2. The participant must enter in the category prescribed for his grade.

5. All entries must be clean and not over handled.
6. Machine stitching means practical (utility) stitches, decorative stitches and buttonholes.
7. All trimmings used, must be washable.
8. NO machine embroidery will be allowed.
9. Only individual designs will qualify for judging – NO GROUP WORK!
10. No name may be stitched or painted on the article.

12. An entry form must accompany all entries. The entry form should be securely attached to the inside of the garment.
13. The entry form must be completed in full. Incomplete information may result in disqualification of the entry.
14. Parents or guardians must sign the entry form.
15. The signing of the entry form constitutes a basic agreement between BERNINA and the person who enters, and this agreement binds the person entering the competition to act strictly according to the rules of the competition and ensures that BERNINA will present and run the competition strictly according to the rules. Transgression or breaking of the rules of this competition may result in the disqualification of the entry.
16. All the entries must reach BERNINA not later than October 12, 2015.
17. Entries can be handed in at participating BERNINA Dealers or at BERNINA RSA – 9 Lime Street, Auckland Park, Johannesburg.
